

## Correction to Company Announcement

Unfortunately, there is a mistake in the growth figures of beer and other beverage volume in Central & Eastern Europe in the 2023 FY announcement released this morning.

Please find correct figures and explanation below:

Volumes were also impacted by the termination of the Kronenbourg 1664 licensee agreement in the UK, which was previously managed in the Export & License division. Consequently, organic beer volume development was -4.0%. Other beverage volumes declined organically by 4.2%, despite growth of energy drinks in the eastern part of the region.
